

How is SOYFAI setup?

SOYFAI is divided into two divisions separating small communities and larger communities. The large community division is referred to as the North Division and consists of the following teams;

Harrison
Colerain
Forest Hills
Sycamore
West Clermont

The small community division known as the South Division consists of the following teams;

Reading
Wyoming
Western Brown
Delhi

Each division has its own playoff and super bowl, with four teams being eligible per division. Teams are eligible for their divisions playoffs based on points accumulated within their division.

How do teams accumulate points?

3 points are awarded for each win against a divisional opponent. Points are not taken away for losses nor are they awarded for non-divisional games.

What happens in the event two division teams accumulate the same amount points by the end of the season?

A tie-breaker game will be played the day after the last game of the season, this season the date is October 28th. The location and game times are TBD.

Upon the conclusion of tie-breaker games North Division playoff seeds are awarded. Teams will be seeded 1 thru 4, with the 1 and 4 seed playing on Saturday November 3rd, while the 2 and 3 seeds will play Sunday November 4th. The North Division playoffs will be held at Harrison in 2007. Again, game times are TBD.

The two winning teams will advance to the North Division Super Bowl to be held Sunday November 11th at Sycamore High School. Again, game times are TBD.
